

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONER COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS
REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2018**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 10TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2018 there came to be held a Regular Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Genevie Sheets, Commissioner Precinct 2; Dee Vaughan, Commissioner Precinct 3; Lynn Cartrite, Commissioner Precinct 4; and Teresa Henry, Deputy County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Cartrite to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of November 13, 2018. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried. Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the minutes of the Special Called Meeting of November 19, 2018. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Cartrite. Motion carried. Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of November 26, 2018. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Cartrite. Motion carried.

.Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the Temporary Cash Investments dated December 10, 2018 as presented by James Allen, County Auditor, be approved and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Cartrite. Motion carried. Copies of the Report and the Temporary Cash Investments are attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cartrite that the bills as presented by James Allen, County Auditor, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried.

Brandon Jones, Deputy Sheriff presented a brochure on the Step Grant for the Sheriff's Dept. He stated that TxDot defines zones within the county that are considered to be dangerous. He stated the grant would pay deputies to patrol the defined areas and will be allotted \$12,000.00 for the first year if approved the program would start October, 2019. Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Sunray ISD and Moore County Sheriff's Dept. with changes as discussed. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried. Copy of agreement attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Sheets to approve the employment of Kelcie Crawford as a dispatcher for the Sheriff's Dept. effective November 26, 2018 with a starting salary of \$20.49 per hour with a .50 increase every six months for one year. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to table the purchase of a vehicle for EOC. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Commissioner Vaughan amended his motion to table the purchase of a vehicle for EOC until after they examine the current Interlocal Agreement between Moore County and the City of Dumas. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cartrite to table the action on bid for land struck off tax roles for Lot 135 Unit 1 Double Diamond Estates. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cartrite to table the action on bid for land struck off tax roles for Lot 136 Unit 1 Double Diamond Estates. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the purchase of a printer for the County Clerk's office in the amount of \$3,820.00 with the expenditure to be paid \$2,000.00 from the County Clerk's Records Management Fund and \$1,820.00 from the Election Supply Budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Sheets. Motion carried.


Travis Smith, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Travis stated he had asked the City of Dumas to borrow a piece of equipment to assist in the tumbleweed cleanup at the West Subdivision. He stated the city denied his request and he wanted the court to be aware of some of the issues that he is having with the city. He also stated he has received several invoices from the city for water usage. Commissioner Cartrite suggest they look at the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Dumas and Moore County in regard to the amount of water used. Travis stated Mark's new pickup should be ready this week and he may use his old pickup as a mowing pickup. He stated they are patching Road E and should be done this week. He stated after cotton harvest he would like to take a look and see what needs to be done with Road E. Travis stated Morton Road is only about ¾ inch thick and he is concerned there might be some problems if they try to put rumble strips down and he is looking at other solutions.

It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner Sheets to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.




Commissioner Precinct 3, Dee Vaughan
