

EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2022, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Moore County resulting from

The vehicle and truck traffic on Co Rd I and Buddy Kline Roads continues to occur and the roads continue to deteriorate due to the traffic and it continues to be a public safety hazard;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT of Moore County:

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the County of Moore by the County Judge on June 22, 2022 shall continue until terminated by order of the COMMISSIONERS COURT.

2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code and shall become effective on the 27th day June of 2022


