ORDER APPOINTING COUNTY AUDITOR FOR MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, it has been made known to me, as District Judge of the 69th Judicial District, of which Moore County is a part, that said County has a population exceeding 10,200 according to the last preceding Federal Census. The Court hereby declares that a County Auditor shall be appointed as required by law under the provisions of V.T.C.A., Local Government Code, Section 84.002.

The Court having carefully investigated and considered the qualifications of Coy Barton, a certified public accountant practicing in Dumas, Moore County, Texas, it is the opinion and finding of the court that Mr. Barton is an experienced and qualified person to hold such office.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Kimberly L. Allen, District Judge of the 69th Judicial District, do hereby appoint Coy Barton, as County Auditor of Moore County, Texas, for a term commencing on January 1, 2025, and ending on December 31, 2026.

As County Auditor, Mr. Barton shall receive as compensation for his services an annual salary from the County General Fund equal to that amount allowed or paid the Assessor-Collector of Taxes in Moore County, said salary to be paid monthly out of the General Fund of the County. In the event the compensation received by the Assessor-Collector of Taxes in Moore County is increased within the term encompassed in this Order, the Auditor's compensation for his services shall also be increased accordingly.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Court fixes the salary of the County Auditor as being the same as the Tax Assessor-Collector of Moore County, Texas; this action will be recorded in the Minutes of the District Court of Moore County, and the Clerk for Moore County, Texas, shall certify this Order for





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observance to the Commissioners' Court and cause said Order to be recorded in its Minutes as required by V.T.C.A., Local Government Code, Section 84.003.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Coy Barton shall within twenty (20) days of his appointment and before he enters upon the duties of his office, post a bond with two or more good and sufficient personal sureties, or a good and sufficient Surety Bond in the minimum sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) payable to the District Judge, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties. Said Bond shall be payable and conditioned as set forth by law and Mr. Barton shall also subscribe to the official oath as provided by law.
