Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Commissioners Miles Mixon and Dee Vaughan were absent from the meeting.

During routine announcements and reports Chris Rivera, Tax Assessor Collector presented his Certificate of completed hours from the Tax Assessor-Collector Association. Copy of certificates attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia that the bills as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

There was one bill presented for Special Handling:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garica to approve a payment to JBI LTD in the amount of \$4,344.60 to with expenditure to be paid from SCAAP Grant. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the application to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for purposes of crime victim assistance and investigations of victim crimes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the payment to Home Depot in the amount of \$853.33 with expenditure to be paid from 69<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office Forfeiture Account for the purposes of remodeling and renovating the 69<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the expenditure of \$6,000.00 for the purposes of sending 69<sup>th</sup> Judicial Agency Law Enforcement Officers to the A.C.E.I.T. to be paid from the 69<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Forfeiture Account. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia, Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the application for the Rifle Resistant Body Armor Grant with is a 100% funded grant and approve the application for the JAG Grant which is

a reimbursement grant which is 50% funded. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni for the County Attorney to draft an agreement with City of Sunray Fire Dept. in regards to the City of Sunray Fire Dept. being located on county land. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve getting an appraisal property on Sec. 269 Blk. 44 H&TC that is located on E. 1st Street. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Raymond Tate, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave a report on the department. Raymond stated he was contacted by ISCS(fka DCP Midstream) in regards to people getting stuck on Hooks Road. They would like to put 3-4 loads per month towards the highway and he stated it would take approximately 2 years to complete.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to move forward with the repairs on Hooks Road. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.
