Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 14, 2025 and Special Meeting of April 28, 2025. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia that the bills as presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated May 12, 2025 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to send a letter protesting the budget for Moore County Appraisal District and send a letter to other taxing entities protesting the extra employee and the 3% salary increase across the board and the Eagleview contract. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of letter attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the interlocal collections contracts for 2025 as presented by Chris Rivera, Tax Assessor Collector. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of contracts attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to advertise and issue a request for proposal for Bank Depository Services. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to lift burn ban effective immediately. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of order to lift burn ban attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the purchase of an in-car computer for the EOC in the amount of \$2,842.48 with \$1,000.00 of the cost to be paid out of the EOC travel budget with remaining balance to be paid out of office supply budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve a Proclamation declaring May 11-17, 2025 as Police Memorial Week. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried. Copy of proclamation attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to request that all budgets be turned in by May 30, 2025 to County Judge and the court will hear from elected officials regarding their budget request on June 9th and June 23rd. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to assist City of Cactus with their seal coat project this year and have County Attorney prepare an interlocal agreement between Moore County and City of Cactus. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Raymond Tate, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Commissioner Garcia asked about the potholes on Road G. He stated they need to be repaired, and they have been there for over a month. He stated the culverts on Road E and Starkey Road need to be cleaned out. Raymond stated his plans are to seal coat seven miles this year. He has received bids from J Milligan and Big Creek for seal coat rock.

At 10:43 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan that the court enter in Executive Session according to Govt. Code Section 551.074 to discuss personnel matters. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. At 11:43 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan that the court reconvene in open court. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Judge Rhoades stated no action taken on agenda during Executive Session and certifies to the agenda.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon based on input from Raymond Tate, Road & Bridge Supervisor that Moore County begin a search for a new Road & Bridge Supervisor and subsequently review the job description and post notice accordingly. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.
