BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 4TH DAY OF APRIL, 2025 there came to be held an Emergency Special Called Meeting of Commissioners Court, in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Moore County, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4; and County Clerk Brenda McKanna, County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Commissioners Garcia and Vaughan were absent from the meeting.

Tommy Brooks, Emergency Operations Coordinator stated the disaster declaration that was put in place on March 28, 2025 was for seven days and the declaration needs to be extended which will allow the county to obtain state and federal resources if there is a need to receive additional funding.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to extend the Disaster Declaration regarding the explosion of the grain elevator and loss of natural gas to residents and businesses in Sunray for an additional 30 days effective April 4, 2025. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of disaster declaration attached and made a part hereof by reference.

It appearing that there was no other business to come before the Court at this time, motion was made by Commissioner Mixon that the meeting stand adjourned. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

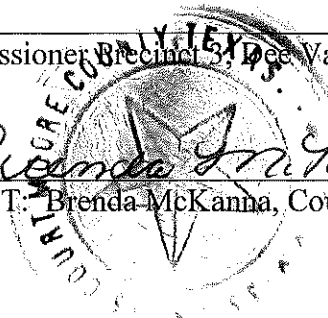
