BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 14<sup>th</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2025 there came to be held a Regular Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1; Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Chief Deputy Clerk, Cindy Sullivan.

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Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

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Commissioner Vaughan was absent from the meeting.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the bills that are due on July 28<sup>th</sup> to be paid due to next meeting being moved to July 31, 2025. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni that the bills as presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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There were two bills presented for special handling:  
Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the payment to PCV Apps in the amount of \$7,241.25 with expenditure to be paid from the SCAAP Grant. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the payment to TDJC in the amount of \$9,784.00 with expenditure to be paid from the SCAAP Grant. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated July 14, 2025 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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Josh Butler, representative of Butler Benefits & Consulting regarding the health insurance renewal. Josh presented several different options for the court to consider and reported that there will be a 10% increase in the insurance rate.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to accept the proposal from Josh Butler and renew with Blue Cross Blue Shield. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of proposal attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve Justice of Peace Precincts 1 and 2 changing to Texas Panhandle Forensic for autopsies effective August 1, 2025. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the County Child Welfare Service Non-Financial Agreement. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of agreement attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the modifications on the PRPC Interlocal Agreement for E9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Point Services. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried. Copy of agreement attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the Resolution with PRPC for 911 Equipment and Services. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of resolution attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the hiring of a replacement for a Children's Librarian at the Killgore Memorial Library. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the 2025 Certified Mileage for Moore County of 335 miles. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of certification attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the EOC declaring the camper as surplus property and arranging for its disposal. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to take "No Action" regarding a Memorandum of Understanding between ICE and the Moore County Sheriff's Office to comply with Mandated Policies put in place by the Governor's Office until the County Attorney can get more information for the court. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the rehire of Elvia Zapata as a full-time deputy district clerk as a replacement position effective July 7, 2025 with a salary of \$4,005.23 per month. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to take "No Action" and table until the next meeting regarding the purchase of a Utility Terrain Vehicle for the Sheriff's Office. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the purchase of a new computer/server to host Commissioners Court Minutes and document images in the amount of \$2,103.99 with expenditure to be paid from County Clerk Records Management Fund. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.


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Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to advertise for bailing grass at the airport. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.



Commissioner Garcia stated shoulder on Schuman Road needed to be pulled up and asked Raymond to check on Road L.


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During budget work session Coy Barton, County Auditor, Melissa Martinez and County Treasurer, Kara Milligan were present for the budget work session. There was a list of used dump trucks presented with prices. The court asked Raymond what equipment he needed most, and he stated he needed a steel wheel roller, dump trucks, semi-truck and tractors for mowing. Erin Lands Anchondo stated she is trying to communicate with the other counties regarding her budget and will keep the court informed.

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It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.
