BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 29th DAY OF JUNE, 2026 there came to be held a Special Called Meeting of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1; Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Dee Vaughan, Commissioner Precinct 3; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Brenda McKanna, County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

At 8:59 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Farni that the court enter in Executive Session according to Govt. Code Sec. 551.074 to discuss personnel matters regarding County Treasurer personnel. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

At 9:40 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Garcia that the court reconvene in open court. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan that the Commissioners Court under Texas LGC 111.010(c) recognize that there is an emergency situation in the County Treasurer's office created by a required medical leave regarding an employee; the Commissioners Court in response will grant a \$4.00 per hour supplement for the existing unelected employee during the duration of the leave effective during the current budget year; the supplement will begin once the medical leave begins and end once the employee returns to full time employment or September 30, 2026 whichever comes first. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of LGC 111.010 attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to rescind the overtime pay that was approved for the Treasurer's office on June 22, 2026. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

As part of this budget amendment the County Auditor will amend the budget for 2026 and submit the amendment to the County Clerk's Office in compliance with the LGC 111.010(c).

It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon Motion carried.
