

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONERS COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS
SPECIAL SESSION, MONDAY, MARCH, 23, 2026**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 2026 there came to be held a Special Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioner’s Courtroom of the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to wit: County Judge, Rowdy Rhoades; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1; Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Brenda McKanna, County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Commissioner Vaughan was absent from the meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of February 23, 2026 and the Regular Meeting of March 9, 2026. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon Motion carried. Judge Rhoades “Abstained.”

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia that the bills presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

There were two bills presented for special handling:

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the payment in the amount of \$1,619.98 to IT Uptime with expenditure to be paid out of the SCRAM revenue. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the payment in the amount of \$1,618.75 to Shad McDaniel Engineering. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to accept the 2025 annual audit as presented by John Merriss with Doshier, Pickens and Francis, LLC. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of report on file in the County Clerk’s Office.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to allow extra hours for Jillian Shockey, airport employee with expenditure to be paid out of airports part-time budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve moving Mac Fields to District Attorney Investigator effective March 9, 2026 with a monthly salary of \$5,805.92 plus \$350.00 in travel and SB22 salary supplement of \$1,234.50. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the Proclamation declaring April 2026 as Child Abuse Awareness Month in Moore County. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried. Copy of proclamation attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve using the courthouse lawn for the annual pinwheel ceremony. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the employment of Riley Goolsby as a replacement deputy effective March 25, 2026 with a starting salary of \$30.71 per hour with a .50 increase every six months for one year and a \$100.00 per month clothing allowance with Riley being designated as the SB22 officer with salary to be paid out of grant funds. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the MOU between Moore County Sheriff's Office and Hartley County Sheriff's Office. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried. Copy of MOU attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve a Resolution for 287G. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of resolution attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Flood Management Evaluation as presented. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of evaluation attached and made a part hereof by references.


Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve action regarding HB2560 Adopt a County Road. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the employment of James Walker as an apprentice with Road & Bridge effective March 10, 2026 with a starting salary of \$18.00 per hour with a six month pay evaluation for five years. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.


